### WHPD Case #10-6079

On April 29, 2010 at about 2:30 P.M. an adult w/m subject, John Doe, was discovered unconscious with no identification in the 500 block of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street NW near the Winter Haven Fire Department. Winter Haven police are seeking public assistance in identifying this subject who is currently at Winter Haven Hospital and has not regained consciousness. His description is as follows:

- White male, approximately 30-40 years old
- 5'10" tall, 210 lbs.
- Short brown hair and blue eyes
- He was wearing a red shirt and black jogging pants and had a GMC vehicle key in his pocket when he was found.

This John Doe has several very distinct tattoos that might lead to the discovery of his identity (see attached tattoo photos).

No evidence of foul play has been discovered, however we are continuing to investigate. Anyone with information involving the identity of this individual, and/or the circumstances that led to his current condition is asked to contact Detective Steve Rusich at (863) 291-5304.

We have no further information to release at this time.
